STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS SCHOOL NEEDS *Section 1114 (b)(7)(A)*

The following strategies will be implemented to address prioritized school needs:

- Supplemental Instruction
 - Math will serve grades K-4
 - ELA will serve grades K-4
 - Delivery of supplemental instruction will include push in services within the regular classroom and also pull out services in the resource room
 - 2 instructional personnel will be provided (1 Math, 1 ELA)
- Response to Intervention will be implemented for students with instructional needs

The strategies will:

- provide opportunities for all children, including subgroups of students, to meet the challenging Missouri Learning Standards
- Use methods and instructional strategies that strengthen the academic program in the school
- Increase the amount of learning time

Activities that address the needs of those at risk of not meeting the Missouri Learning Standards will include:

- Address the needs of all children in the school, but particularly the needs of those at risk of not meeting the Missouri Learning Standards
- Improve students' skills outside the academic subject areas
- Provide professional development and other activities for teachers, paraprofessionals, and other school personnel to improve instruction and use of data
- Assist preschool children in the transition from early childhood education programs to local elementary school programs
